Sustainability and Innovation	The model lacks sustainable or innovative ideas.	The student has demonstrated a sustainable or innovative idea.	The student's model demonstrates ideas that are sustainable and innovative.
Model Layout	The model has not focussed on a city or area and is unorganized.	The model is organized and easy to understand. Road signs, labels and some creative ideas have been used.	The model is organized and presented neatly with signs; labels clearly indicated and includes an impressive safety layout.
