- 4. Which month(s) represents high fog? Why do you think there is more fog during this month(s)?
- 5. Which month(s) represents low fog? Why do you think there is less fog during this month(s)?
- 6. What is fog measured in?
- 7. Interpreting Figure 27 (d) on page 61, what are the significant weather events represented?
- Which month(s) do the statistics demonstrate more lightning, CB Cloud and Thunderstorms? Explain why you think this might be.
- What does a CB Cloud weather event mean? Research and represent this in your presentation.
