Illegal Migration

The movement of people into a country in violation of the immigration of that country. This might include people who do not have a legal right to stay in the country and they do not have a visa or permit to be in the country.

Refugee


A person or people who are unable or unwilling to return to the source country of origin out of a well-founded fear of being persecuted for reasons of race, religion, nationality membership of a particular social group or political opinion.

Push Factor

Reasons that make people want to leave an area or country.



Pull Factor

Reasons that attract people to live in a particular area or country.



Source country

The home country of a migrant. The migrant's country of origin.

Host country

The country that will host the migrants. The destination country for a migrant.
