3	Creativity and Innovation in Project Design Originality and creativity in conceptualizing the community initiative. Practicality and sustainability of the proposed project ideas.		
4	Collaboration and Teamwork Demonstrate effective communication and collaboration within the group. Ability to integrate diverse ideas and work cohesively towards a common goal.		
5	Problem-Solving and Critical Thinking Show competency in identifying and addressing challenges during the project. Apply critical thinking to analyze issues and develop viable solutions.		
6	Community Engagement and Impact Level of engagement with the local community and stakeholders. Tangible impact of the project on promoting cultural awareness or addressing community needs.		
7	Presentation and Communication Skills Clarity, coherence, and persuasiveness in presenting the project. Use of appropriate visual aids and effective communication strategies.		
8	Reflection and Self-Assessment Depth of reflection on personal and group learning experiences. Ability to critically assess project outcomes and personal contributions.
